

Data protection policy

We are especially committed to the protection of your personal data. We process your data exclusively on the basis of the statutory regulations (GDPR, Austrian Telecommunications Act 2003). **With this data protection information, we wish to inform you of the key aspects of data processing in the context of our website.**

1. Contacting us

If you contact us via the contact form on the website or via email, the data you have provided will be stored with us for the purpose of processing your inquiry and in case of follow-up questions. We will not disclose this data without your consent.

If you enter into a contract with us, these data will be stored within the company for at least the term of the contract.

2. Data storage

Please note that, within the context of your inquiry, the following data will be stored with us:

- Name of the key contact within the client company or interested company
- Telephone number and email address of the key contact
- Position of the key contact within the client company or interested company

The data provided by you are necessary for performance of the contract or the implementation of pre-contractual measures. We cannot enter into a contract with you without this data. The data will not be disclosed to third parties, with the exception of our tax advisor in the performance of our fiscal obligations. All data resulting from the contractual relationship will be stored for the term of the contract; at least, however, until expiry of the fiscal retention period.

This data will be used to communicate with the key contact within the client company or interested company.

The data shall be processed on the basis of the statutory provisions of Sect. 96 Para 3 of the Telecommunications Act and Article 6(1)a (consent) and/or b (necessary for performance of a contract) of the GDPR.

3. Cookies

Our website uses so-called cookies. These are small text files which are stored on your end device with the aid of the browser. They do not cause any damage.

We use cookies to make our services more user-friendly. Some cookies remain stored on your end device until you delete them. They allow us to recognize your browser again on your next visit.

You can prevent cookies from being stored by using the appropriate settings in your browser software. Deactivating cookies may limit the functionality of our website.

4. Web analysis

Our website uses functions provided by the web analysis provider Google Analytics. This service is provided by Google Inc. (1600 Amphitheatre Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA) and uses cookies to enable the analysis of the use of our website by your users. The information generated in this way is transferred to the provider's server and stored there.

You can prevent this from happening by changing the settings on your browser so that cookies are not stored.

All appropriate measures are taken to ensure that this service can be used in compliance with data protection policy.

Our interest, in the sense of the GDPR (legitimate interest), lies in improving our services and Internet presence. As the privacy of our users is very important to us, the user data are anonymised.

The relationship to the web analysis provider is based on an Adequacy Decision granted by the European Commission ("Privacy Shield"), which guarantees an adequate data protection level for data transfers to certified companies in the USA.

The data shall be processed on the basis of the statutory provisions of Sect. 96 Para 3 of the Telecommunications Act and Article 6(1)f (legitimate interest) of the GDPR.

5. Newsletter

You can subscribe to our newsletter via our website. For this, we will need your email address and confirmation that, by subscribing to our newsletter, you consent to the processing of the personal data you have provided for the purpose of sending you the newsletter.

Once you have registered for the newsletter, we will send you a confirmation email with a link to confirm your registration.



You can cancel your newsletter subscription at any time. To cancel your subscription, click on the corresponding "unsubscribe" link in the newsletter email. The data stored in connection with your newsletter subscription will then be deleted.

6. Your rights

You have the **right of information, correction, deletion, limitation, data portability, withdrawal and objection**. If you believe that the processing of your data violates the Data Protection Act or that their data protection interests are being violated in any other way, you may lodge a complaint with the regulatory authorities. In Austria, this is the Data Protection Authority.
